

Step-by-Step Tutorial: Make Art in the Style of Marcel Duchamp!

What You'll Need:

- A few clean everyday objects (e.g., spoon, cup, toy wheel, comb, bottle)
- A pen or sticky label
- Glue or tape (optional)
- A big piece of paper or card
- Imagination!

 **Step 1: Choose Your Object or choose two objects and stick them together** (choose two things very different, like an apple and a shoe)




 **Step 2: Give It a Funny Name**

 **Step 3: Put It on Display – maybe place it on top of a box, or on a table**

 **Step 4: Create a Title Card**

 **Step 5: Explain Your Art**

More Fun Duchamp-Inspired Ideas:

-  **Object Mash-Up:** Glue two odd things together (like a cup on a shoe!) and give it a story.
-  **Chess Art:** Draw or build a chessboard, then make crazy characters as the pieces!
-  **Invisible Art:** Make up an artwork that doesn't exist — then explain it to others as if they could see it!
