Iris van Herpen: Art Challenge Pack

Explore fashion, nature, and science through hands-on creativity! Inspired by the magical work of Dutch fashion designer **Iris van Herpen**, these five challenges invite you to create your own wearable art, nature-inspired designs, and futuristic fashion experiments.

6 Challenge 1: Swirling Sea Creatures

Theme: Ocean magic from *Sensory Seas* **Make:** Hanging jellyfish or coral mobiles

You'll need:

- Tissue paper (in ocean colours)
- · Pipe cleaners or string
- Scissors
- Glitter glue or sequins
- Sticky tape or glue

Instructions:

- 1. Cut long wavy strips from tissue paper.
- 2. Twist pipe cleaners into curly tentacles.
- 3. Glue your sea shapes together to make jellyfish or coral.
- 4. Hang them from string to make your own underwater world!

Bonus Challenge: Make a whole reef scene using recycled plastic!

© Challenge 2: Wearable Art Headbands

Theme: Sculptural shapes from her runway shows

Make: A futuristic headpiece or crown

You'll need:

- Cardboard or thick paper
- Tin foil or metallic paper
- Glue or tape
- A plain headband or elastic
- Scissors

Instructions:

- 1. Cut spirals, waves, or zigzag shapes.
- 2. Wrap them in foil for a shiny effect.
- 3. Attach them to a headband or band of card.
- 4. Model your design in front of the mirror!
- Bonus Challenge: Name your creation and design a matching outfit!

Challenge 3: Paper Fashion Sculptures

Theme: Iris's famous 3D-printed dresses **Make:** A layered paper dress or costume

You'll need:

- Coloured paper
- Scissors and glue
- A small toy or paper doll (or draw your own!)
- Tracing paper or tissue paper

Instructions:

- 1. Cut out different shapes—circles, diamonds, strips.
- 2. Layer and glue them like a dress, adding folds and pop-up parts.
- 3. Create see-through or fluttery layers with tissue paper.
- 4. Dress up your paper figure in your masterpiece!
- Bonus Challenge: Make a mini fashion show with friends or family.

Challenge 4: Mood Colour Capes

Theme: Feelings, flow, and colour **Make:** An expressive mood cape

You'll need:

- An old pillowcase or piece of fabric
- Fabric paint or markers
- Paintbrushes or sponges
- Scissors (ask for help)
- Arts Award Initiative Ltd

Instructions:

- 1. Think about a feeling (happy, calm, wild!) and choose colours to match it.
- 2. Paint patterns that swirl, twist, or dance across your fabric.
- 3. Cut a hole for your head and wear your cape proudly!

Nake capes for different moods and match them to music!

Challenge 5: Nature Texture Rubbings

Theme: Nature's shapes like shells and fossils **Make:** A textured design board for a fashion idea

You'll need:

- Paper
- Crayons or charcoal
- Natural objects: leaves, shells, bark, stones
- Glue and scissors

Instructions:

- 1. Put paper over your object.
- 2. Rub gently with crayon to pick up the texture.
- 3. Try different textures and colours.
- 4. Cut and glue your favourite rubbings into a design.
- Bonus Challenge: Turn your textures into a dress or jacket sketch!
