#### **Gustav Klimt**

#### What did Gustav Klimt create?

Gustav Klimt was a painter from Austria who loved to use **gold**, **patterns**, **and beautiful shapes** in his art. He painted **portraits**, **nature**, **and magical scenes**, often with sparkly gold and swirling designs. His work is very decorative and unique!



### Childhood

- Gustav was born in 1862 in Baumgarten, near Vienna, Austria.
- His dad was a gold engraver, which inspired Klimt's love for gold in art.
- Gustav Klimt was the **second of seven children**, and three of his brothers became artists.
- His family moved to **Vienna when he was young**, which later became central to his artistic career.
- As a child, Klimt loved **drawing and copying artwork** from books and magazines.
- He grew up in a very modest household, and his family often struggled to afford materials, so he learned to be creative with what he had.

- At age 14, Gustav got a scholarship to the Vienna School of Arts and Crafts.
- At the Vienna School of Arts and Crafts, he studied under **Ferdinand Laufberger**, a famous decorative artist.
- He learned how to paint and draw very realistically.
- He studied architecture, fashion, and murals.
- He admired **classical art**, but later developed his own special style.
- He learned to design **theatrical costumes and stage sets**, which later influenced his decorative style.
- Klimt received a gold medal for excellence in one of his school exhibitions.

### Career

- Gustav started by painting walls and ceilings in big buildings.
- He co-founded a group called the Vienna Secession, which celebrated new and modern art.
- His painting style became very decorative and full of patterns.
- Some people loved his art, while others found it **strange or shocking**.
- Klimt's early professional work included painting **ceiling murals for theatres and museums** across Austria.
- In 1894, Klimt was asked to paint three major panels for the University of Vienna, but they were considered too radical and controversial.
- His unique style developed into the "Golden Phase", using gold leaf and symbolic designs, which became his signature.
