Step-by-Step Tutorial: Create a Gesso-Inspired Panel

Create an Art Nouveau panel like Margaret's

Materials:

- · A sheet of thick paper or card
- A pencil
- A black pen
- · Glitter glue, cotton wool, or string for raised texture
- · Watercolour paints or coloured pencils

Step 1: Draw a Dreamy Face

Start by sketching an **oval face** with **closed eyes** and a **calm expression** in the centre of your page.

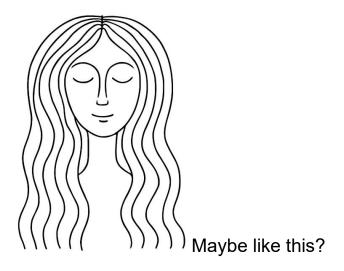

Step 2: Add Long, Flowing Hair

Draw long, wavy lines from the head down to the bottom of the page. Let them **twirl and curl** like ribbons.

step 3: Decorate with Nature

Add **flowers**, **leaves**, **and stars** in the hair and background. You can use shapes like **teardrops**, **circles**, **and ovals**.



Maybe like this? Your illustration choices will be different, but we do recommend some Mackintosh roses somewhere.

Step 4: Add Texture

Use **glitter glue**, **cotton wool**, **or string** to go over some of the lines or shapes to make them **raised**, like Margaret's gesso panels.

Step 5: Add Colour

Use **soft, dreamy colours** like lilac, pale blue, peach, or gold. Colour gently to keep the design light and floaty.
