Childhood

- Born in Tokyo, Japan in 1941
- Grew up during World War II, which influenced his stories
- Loved drawing planes, tanks, and flying machines
- Inspired by manga (Japanese comics) from a young age
- His father worked for an aeroplane parts factory

Education

- Studied political science and economics at Gakushuin University
- Continued learning by self-studying animation and storytelling
- Joined a manga club at university and practised drawing characters
- Learned animation techniques while working in studios rather than at art school

Career

Started as an in-between artist at Toei Animation in the 1960s

Arts Award Initiative Ltd

- Co-founded Studio Ghibli in 1985 with Isao Takahata
- Directed some of the most loved animated films in the world
- Spirited Away won an Academy Award for Best Animated Feature
- Known for hand-drawn animation and detailed backgrounds
- Retired multiple times... but always came back to create more films!
